
The Australian Sports Turf Managers Association currently delivers formal training and assessment for Nationally Recognised Training Qualifications in Sports Turf Management including the;

AHC31319 Certificate III in Sports Turf Management

Certificate III in Sports Turf Management AHC31319 is designed for Apprentices.

This program develops the competencies required to grow and maintain high quality sports turf surfaces such as cricket, rugby league, horse racing, soccer, lawn tennis, lawn bowls and golf.

Entry Requirements

The Australian Sports Turf Managers Association (ASTMA) requires students:

- · Have commenced as a licenced apprentice in the vocation of Sports Turf Management (AHC31319) or currently work within Sports Turf Management or related industries.
- 18 years of age or over and have completed high school or have been provided with an application from the board of studies to enter in the qualification.
- · Complete a language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) assessment to demonstrate that they have the required level of LLN skills required by the course.

Course Information

Students will undertake 23 units of competence including;

- Contribute to WHS Processes
- · Operate Machinery and Equipment
- Soil Science
- Renovate Sports Turf
- Prepare Sports Turf Surfaces for Play
- · Establish Turf
- Pest Management
- Chemical Application (AQF3 Chemical Applicators Licence)
- Irrigation Operation, Maintenance and Installation
- Implement a Plant Nutrition Program
- **Construct Turf Playing Surfaces**

Training

Training is conducted in a blended format, weekly (35 weeks per year) over three years. Students will undertake weekly online tutorial sessions and meet four times a year (Monday-Thursday) at some of the countries finest sporting venues, as a group to network and complete practical skills training and assessment in block sessions.

AHC51019 Diploma of Sports Turf Management

The Diploma of Sports Turf Management is ideal for individuals working in the sports turf area who currently hold a Certificate III in Sports Turf Management, and are looking to advance their career into senior pr management positions. This qualification enhances the skills and knowledge for management roles in sports turf.

It applies to individuals who are responsible for the management of sports turf facilities and who analyse information and exercise judgement to complete a range of advanced skilled activities and demonstrate deep knowledge in specific technical areas. They have accountability for the work of others and analyse, design and communicate solutions to a range of complex problems.

Entry Requirements

To commence this qualification an individual must have:

- completed a Certificate III in Sports Turf Management or an equivalent turf management trade level qualification, or
- a certificate III level qualification in amenity horticulture combined with two years current work experience in a trade level role at a sports turf facility, and
- complete a language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) assessment to demonstrate that they have the required level of LLN skills required by the course

Course Information

Students will undertake 14 units of competence including;

- Manage Enterprise Staff Requirement
- · Develop Policies and Procedures for Sustainability
- Audit Irrigation Systems
- Manage Sports Turf Facility Assets
- Develop a Soil Health and Plant Nutrition Program, and Management Programs
- Manage Trail and Research Material
- Prepare and Monitor Budgets and Financial Reports

Training

This qualification is delivered virtually (online) over two years, to offer greater flexibility and accessibility for turf professionals.

Face to Face tutorials will be conducted weekly, one unit at a time, covering curriculum criteria and assessment requirement. Assessments will be short answer written questions covering the knowledge evidence of the unit and portfolio of evidence consisting of work-based reports and student presentations for each unit. You will be provided with all resources on commencement of each unit.
