Volunteer Hours

To support the event and meet the expectations of key stakeholders (i.e., event organisers, the players, members and public) working hours may vary during tournament week, depending on weather, play and maintenance requirements.

The hours on tournament days where we will be preparing the course for play will between 3.30 am and 8.30 pm with an extended break during the day. An expanded schedule is below.

We will have a team meeting each morning at 3.30 am sharp; this will include roll call and a run through of tasks for the morning and any updates/tournament info. We will be heading out onto the golf course at 3.45 am, please ensure you are punctual to meet these times.

On tournament days and Pro-Am (Wednesday), the hours will be based around access to the golf course (i.e., 3 am-8 am and 4 pm-8 pm).

Location

Entry to the turf care facility is under the gateway bridge Curtin Ave **East**, Eagle Farm.

In terms of punctuality all volunteers must ensure they are ready to commence on time. It is important that everyone reports to Tim Peters or Luke Bonner if you are going to be late or absent. Please contact them directly and as soon as possible and well in advance of the scheduled start.

It is also requested that during the tournament period that we are all contactable outside of rostered hours in case of emergency (Storms, heavy rainfall etc). Please ensure we have all your details.

Personal appearance

Due to the high-profile nature of the tournament, please ensure that your personal appearance (i.e., uniforms, footwear, headwear etc. are always presented and worn appropriately for the week.

Royal Queensland Golf Club will provide 3 x Polo shirts, 1 x Cap, 1 x wide brim hat and a headlamp for the tournament. It would be appreciated if all volunteers could wear appropriate shorts or pants **preferably** navy-blue drill works shorts or pants.

Please bring waterproofs for inclement weather.

Meals

Meals will be supplied during tournament week. This will consist of a meal after the morning shift and in the afternoon before the afternoon shift. The meals will be provided every day.

Rules

To support us in hosting a successful event and preventing any avoidable issues, the below rules apply during the event period:

- No Alcohol on the premises until after the tournament finishes. There will be a post tournament event on the Sunday.
